### **City of Houston Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) dedicated to the arts**

The Texas Tax Code states that the revenue from the municipal hotel occupancy tax may only be used to promote tourism and the convention and hotel industry for certain purposes including the encouragement, promotion, improvement, and application of the arts (Chapter 351).



### HOT Contract with the four arts groups

- 2016 is year three of a five year agreement
- The arts groups are guaranteed a base allocation of about \$15.7 million, plus 50 percent of the growth, if any, of HOT over the preceding year
- Annual funding allocation is determined by the Finance Department using the formula in the contract
