GSD Portfolio

- Police, Fire, Health, Library, Public Works, Administration and Regulatory Affairs, Houston Emergency Center, Houston Transtar and the City Hall Complex.
- 306 Buildings of which 151 are 24 hour facilities.
- 8 Million Square Feet




Pre-Storm Preparedness

- Update Strategic Plan
- Procure storm preparation supplies and materials
- Monitor weather reports
- Inspect and secure buildings and emergency equipment
- Fuel all equipment
- City-wide communications
- Strategically deploy staff



During the Storm

- Occupy Damage Assessment Post at HEC
- Monitor and obtain updates from on site building staff
- Damage control during the storm
 - Insure flood protection devices are working properly
 - Roof leaks
 - Broken windows
 - Mitigate building damage



Post Storm Recovery

- Deploy preliminary inspection teams to identify utility service needs and building damage
- Communicate with CenterPoint
- Deploy emergency generators
- Schedule emergency equipment fueling
- Perform emergency repairs
- Return buildings to operational status



Damage Assessment

- Deploy GSD building professionals to perform damage estimates and assessments
- Documentation Management
 - Provide concise description of damages
 - Photograph all damages
 - Document man hours
 - Track all materials and costs



Restoration

- Assignment of resources
- Emergency Purchase Orders
- Utilization of existing City Contracts
 - GSD Facility Services Contracts
 - Task Order Contracts (Design Services)
 - Job Order (Construction Services)
 - City-wide Contracts
 - Co-op Services Contracts (Buyboard, TXMAS, etc.)
- Major Reconstruction
 - Low-bid, CSP, Design-build, CMAR
