Recognized Charitable Food Service Provider Program
Food Safety Training Schedule**

The Recognized Charitable Food Service Provider Program is a voluntary program whose goal is to attempt to provide coordination of operations to organizations that serve homeless individuals. The Coalition for the Homeless of Houston/Harris County and the Houston Department of Health and Human Services are collaborating on this program.

One important aspect of this program is the attendance of a food safety class. At least one person from each organization should attend a food safety class. If your organization already has a certified food service manager, that is sufficient and no further training is necessary.

To register for a two-hour food safety class, please call the Health Department at 832.393.5100. The class is provided free of charge to food providers. Listed below are the two available class times.
