Sliding fee, discounted schedule, CHIP, Medicaid, Medicare and private insurance accepted. Must bring picture identification. Appointments or walk-ins available. Bee Busy Wellness Center also includes a street outreach team and food pantry.

Caroline Street Clinic opened as a brand new building in February 2016 and provides primary medical care, dental care, and case management Monday through Friday, counseling Monday through Thursday, and psychiatry services on Tuesdays. See website above for hours of operation for each service on each day of the week.
Cathedral Clinic (HHH)	1212 Prairie St, Houston, TX 77002	(713) 220-9730	Mon-Sun, depending on service (see below)	Free clinic owned and operated by Healthcare for the Homeless Houston (HHH) in collaboration with Cathedral Health Ministries. Located in the same building as the Beacon and Compass. The clinic provides primary medical care Monday through Saturday, serves women and children on Tuesdays, case management Monday through Friday, counseling Tuesday through Friday, and psychiatry services on Fridays. They also have a free foot clinic on Saturdays from 9 to 11am, by appointment only. On Sundays the clinic is referred to as HOMES Clinic, run by medical and pharmacy students, but in the same space as Cathedral Clinic. San Jose Clinic	2615 Fannin St, Houston, TX 77002	(713) 228-9411	Mon-Fri, 8am to 5pm	San José Clinic is the original safety-net clinic in Houston and a leading provider of quality healthcare services for individuals and families in the Greater Houston area who struggle with accessing care. They provide primary care, women's health services, specialty care, vision, dental, laboratory and pharmacy services. To receive services at San José Clinic, low-income, uninsured individuals and families must first complete an eligibility interview. Those that qualify for services will receive a patient account, providing them access to services. Eligibility interviews are conducted on a walk-in basis from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. No appointment is necessary. You must bring identification, proof of income and proof of address to your eligibility interview. Examples of what to bring are outlined on their website.
