

## Public Notice

1) The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing to award up to \$3,404,932 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the acquisition and reconstruction of an abandoned 308-unit multifamily property located in City Council District D at 5602 Selinsky Road. The project will be acquired and redeveloped into a 250-unit affordable housing community with updated floor plans, appliances and amenities. The estimated total construction budget is \$40,216,426. The CDBG Funds will come from the unallocated Multifamily line item in various Annual Action Plan years where funding is available.

2) The City, through its HCDD, is proposing to award up to \$2,600,000 in CDBG funds for the acquisition of approximately 277,014 square feet of land and the demolition of existing vacant and substandard structures on property located at 3204 De Soto Street in City Council District B. Once cleared, the land will be greenspace serving as flood mitigation for the area. The CDBG Funds will come from the unallocated Neighborhood Facilities (Public/Private) line item in various Annual Action Plan years where funding is available.

3) The City, through its HCDD, is proposing to award up to \$543,932 in CDBG funds to the City's Solid Waste Management Department to assist with the comprehensive cleanup of illegal dump sites to help reduce mosquito breeding sites in order to help fight the spread of the Zika Virus. The CDBG funds will come from the unallocated Interim Assistance line item in various Annual Action Plan years where funding is available.

The public has thirty days (30) to comment on these proposed items. The thirty-day period extends from Friday, February 26, 2016 through Sunday, March 27, 2016.
