# For your safety, please observe the following regulations in preparing for your visit to the HHW:

- A maximum of 15 gallons or 125 pounds may be transported per vehicle, per trip (Department of Transportation Requirement). *It is illegal to exceed these limits*.
- Containers larger than five (5) gallons will not be accepted.
- Containers will NOT be returned, except for oil containers, upon request.
- Materials such as paint, pesticide, fertilizer, etc. should be in original containers (except motor oil, fuels, and antifreeze).
- All containers must have lids, be sturdy, non-leaking, labeled and protected from breakage.
- Do not combine different types of waste.
- Do not mix oil based paint with latex paint.
- Empty containers with lids removed can be discarded in the trash at your residence or the nearest Neighborhood Depository site. Any paint should be dried prior to disposal.



#### **ReStore** - ESC South Only

(Craft Items, Books, Post Consumer & Industrial Scrap)

The ReStore, which acts as a book swap, a recycling information library, as well as a repository for craft items and post-consumer and postindustrial scrap (useful for art projects), is located at the ESC- South. Items can be dropped off at Westpark and the ESCs during normal service times. Items can be taken away from 9am – 12 noon every Friday during the *Reuse Chemical Take-Away*.

#### **Reuse Chemicals for Shopping Day -**

**ESC South Only** 

Every Friday from 9 am – 12 noon, household chemicals and paint that were brought to the ESC for disposal, but appear to be in good condition are made available for citizen reuse. Citizens may take away these items on a limited basis at no charge. A signed liability waiver will be required before removing materials from the site.

#### What is Household Hazardous Waste?

Leftover household products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive ingredients are considered to be "household hazardous waste" or "HHW." Products, such as paints, cleaners, oils, batteries, and pesticides that contain potentially hazardous ingredients require special care when you dispose of them.

Improper disposal of household hazardous wastes can include pouring them down the drain, on the ground, into storm sewers, or in some cases putting them out with the trash. The dangers of such disposal methods might not be immediately obvious, but improper disposal of these wastes can pollute the environment and pose a threat to human health.

# **Note Regarding Disposal of Expired and Unused Medicine**

Most medicines used in a home are not considered hazardous waste. They can be disposed of in the trash after being secured in durable packaging. Specific disposal instructions can be found at http://www.fda.gov/ForConsumers/ConsumerUpdates/ucm101653.htm.
