

City of Houston Pet Registration Application

Registering your pet is the law. The City of Houston Municipal Code requires that anyone who owns, keeps, possesses, or has control of a dog or cat four months of age or older must have their pet registered, vaccinated against rabies every year, and a registered microchip. A City of Houston pet registration identifies and protects your pet in case it becomes lost. Even indoor pets can get out and become lost. You are required to renew your registration annually and update when you move and/or your pet is given away, lost, stolen, or is deceased.

The City of Houston has gone tag-less due to mandatory microchipping; therefore, you will not receive a tag.
