

HCDD

What is the scope of services to be performed under the contract?

- ➤ Homeowner Opportunity Program: rehabilitation (repair) and reconstruction (replacement) services for eligible <u>homeowners</u>.
- Harvey Recovery Small Rental program: rehabilitation (repair) and reconstruction services for <u>landlords</u> of small multifamily rental properties (no more than 7 rental units).
- ➤ Harvey Single Family Development Program: new construction for approved non-profit and for-profit <u>developers</u>.

What is the timeline for completion of the contract?

- All Hurricane Harvey funds are expected to be spent within 5 years.
- > The first year is to gear up and the last year will be a ramp down
- ➤ Most work is proposed in years 2 4.

What recourse does the city have with contractors?

- ➤ All work is inspected by HCDD staff prior to submission of invoices for payment. No substandard work will be allowed.
- All permitted work has to be inspected by HPW inspectors
- Projects awarded based on the contractor's ability to perform the work, considering all other outstanding projects.
- ➤ If a contractor does not perform, the City may end the contract with 30 days notice.

What is the target population to be served?

- Priority groups for Hurricane Harvey also include:
 - Elderly and disabled
 - Families with children 18 and under
 - Persons earning 50% or below area median income
 - Persons earning 80% or below area median income

- Created through the Tax Reform Act of 1986
- Administered by Texas

 Community Affairs (TDHCA)
- Private equity for construction of affordable homes




- 9% tax credits allocated through competitive process

Mechanics of Tax Credit Allocation



TDHCA 9% Allocation

- TDHCA allocates HTCs among 12 regions-Houston is in Region 6
- In 2019, Houston MSA expected to receive \$14.4M in annual credits
- Represents \$130M+ in total equity over a 10 year period



TDHCA 9% Allocation

- > 2019 preapplications:
 - Over 50 proposals
 - \$88M in annual credits requested








Complete Communities



Two Mile Rule


