



## **HPD Catalytic Converter Incident Timeline**




## **Senate Bill 224**

- Cited as the Deputy Darren Almendarez Act
- Effective May 29, 2023
- Provides a new framework of offenses, penalties and enhancements
  - Criminal Mischief
  - Theft
  - Unauthorized Possession of Catalytic Converter
  - Enhancements
    - Previously convicted under this section
    - Engaged in conspiracy with respect to catalytic converter theft or criminal mischief
    - Possessed a firearm during the commission of the offense
- Provides funding for law enforcement via the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority




# Catalytic Converter thefts Penske Trucks Locations in and around Houston and Harris County



## **HPD Auto Theft Response**

- Response
  - MVCPA Grant Funding
  - Reactive, Proactive, Undercover and Regulatory investigations
  - Streamlined divisional manpower
  - Increased training both within the Auto Theft Division and Department-wide
  - Auto Theft Assistant District Attorney
- Results
  - 2023 v. 2022
    - Total charges filed up 22%
    - Operations conducted up 41%
  - YTD 2024 v. YTD 2023
    - Total charges filed up 19%
    - Operations conducted up 43%
