**Background:** The South Post Oak Redevelopment Authority (Authority) was created to act on behalf of the City of Houston to assist with the design and construction of public infrastructure projects within the TIRZ 9 boundaries such as roadways, sidewalks, street lighting, park facilities, water and sewer utilities, and drainage improvements to promote economic development within the Zone. TIRZ 9 encompasses approximately 1,775 acres situated in the Five Corners District located south of the Texas Medical Center, and generally bound by Highway ALT 90, Beltway 8, and Almeda Road. **Potential Scope of Work:** The Authority will engage one firm to perform Professional Engineering Services for the planning, design, bid phase services, and construction management for a specific public infrastructure project located within the TIRZ 9 boundaries. The project basically consists of a new walking trail around the perimeter of an existing detention basin. The successful Engineer will be required to assist with the acquisition of a right of way easement and a maintenance agreement with the area management district.

- Experience with public agencies and tax increment reinvestment zones (40%).
- Demonstrated qualifications of personnel and team (30%).
- Reputation and experience in professional engineering services (20%).
- Local resources and location of local office (10%).

**Minority and Women Business Enterprises (W/MBE) Practices:** Provide your proposed (M/WBE) subconsultant participation plan and demonstrated good faith efforts to meet or exceed the City of Houston required level of M/WBE participation.
