Completed 60 college hours with a "C" or better, or two years of full time active military service honorable discharge.  Driving Record: 2 or less moving violations in the last 36 months  Ability to complete Fire, and EMT Academy
	Certified Firefighter/ EMT Trainee - FASTTRACK - Minimum Requirements:  □ Between 19 and 36 years of age before taking the Oath of Office.  □ Texas Commission Fire Protection Certification (FIRE) – Basic or Higher  □ Texas Department of State Health Services (EMT) – Basic or Higher  □ Completed 15 college hours with a "C" or better, or College clock hours with Course Completion Certificate  □ Driving Record: 2 or less moving violations in the last 36 months  □ Ability to complete FASTTRACK Academy

	☐ Certificates of Disposition on all <b>driving</b> violations in the last 3 years
	☐ Certificates of Disposition on all <b>criminal</b> violations
	☐ CPR Card – American Heart Association – Health Care Provider (Good for 2 years)
	☐ FINGER PRINTS/CRIMINAL BACKGOUND –Money Order - \$34.25 made payable to HFD
	IMMUNIZATIONS - The applicant shall provide the following prior to receiving a job offer for employment: Hepatitis B series –
	<ul> <li><u>Non-certified</u> applicants must show proof of 2 hepatitis B injections. (Schedule of each injection should follow CDC immunization requirements.)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li><u>Certified</u> applicants must show proof of a complete hepatitis B series. (Schedule of each injection should follow CDC immunization requirements.) If the applicant has received the complete hepatitis B series, but these records are not accessible, an accredited lab report confirming hepatitis B quantitative blood titer equal to or greater than 10 miu/ml will be acceptable.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If the date of the final hepatitis B injection is greater than 2 months prior to submission of the applicant's immunization records, he/she shall also provide an accredited lab report confirming hepatitis B quantitative blood titer equal to or greater than 10 miu/ml. Persons having a titer less than 10 miu/ml will need to show proof of having received a 4<sup>th</sup> hepatitis B injection (booster).</li> </ul>
	☐Tetanus/Diphtheria - Proof of vaccination required with the last five years.
	☐TB Skin test (PPD) documented within the last 6 months. *If a prior positive test, documentation of a negative chest
	X-ray within the last six months shall be provided.
	☐Measles, Mumps, Rubella - Proof of (2) doses of this vaccination is required.
	☐Chickenpox, Herpes Zoster (Varicella-Shingles) If the applicant has had chickenpox, a verbal communication will
