Insurance Services Office (ISO) has submitted a recommendation that extends your fire department response to an area outside the city limits. The Public Protection Class is based on the total percentage credit as follows:

**Divergence is a reduction in credit to reflect a difference in the relative credits for the Fire Department and Water Supply. The difference in protection provided by the fire department and the water supply prevents the better feature from being utilized to its fullest extent. Therefore, an adjustment (divergence) is made to reflect any difference between these two features. Because of the difference in the total weights assigned to the two features, the total for the Fire Department is adjusted to make the comparison reflect the relative adequacies of the two features. Divergence = 50% (100% water supply credit – 80% of fire department credit)
