

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), was awarded Hurricane Ike Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Round 2 Program funding from the Texas General Land Office. The contract allowed the City to carry out multifamily activities which include rehabilitation, reconstruction, and new construction of subsidized housing for households benefiting low- to moderate-income families. To date, there have been seven amendments to the contract.

The CDBG-DR Program Rental Housing Projects Round 2 Grant Agreement (#13-181-00-7294) was executed on January 2, 2013 and will expire on December 31, 2019. HCDD is requesting to extend the contract through December 31, 2021. This extension will ensure completion and closeout for multifamily projects funded under this contract.

The public will have 15 days (fifteen) to comment on this proposed change. The fifteen-day period extends from Wednesday, November 20, 2019 through Thursday, December 5, 2019.
