

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing a substantial amendment to the **Houston Action Plan for Disaster Recovery – 2015 Flood Events** (Plan). Eligibility for the Single Family Housing Program will be broadened by revising the definition of age-dependent household members from above the age of 65 to 62 and below the age of 5 to 18. In addition, the valuation method for acquired properties in the Strategic Buyout Program will be changed from pre-disaster fair market value to post-disaster fair market value.

This would be the fourth amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery 2015 (CDBG-DR15) Action Plan.

The public has fourteen (14) days to comment on this proposed amendment, from Monday, November 18, 2019 through Monday, December 2, 2019.
