Baldemar Rodriguez was born in Mexico and raised in Pasadena, Texas. He graduated from the University of Houston and holds a BA in Radio/Television/Film and a BA in Theater. After graduation and after his mostly-volunteer creative work in theatre, film and television became apparent in the Hispanic and professional communities in Houston, Baldemar was selected as a Media Artist by the *Texas Commission on the Arts*, a lifelong recognition bestowed by the Governor of Texas.

Rodriguez has directed and produced stage productions, documentaries, commercials and PSA's for ABC, NBC, Univision, Telemundo, among others. He worked at Houston's NBC affiliate KPRC TV2 as an editor and news videographer for six years until he was commissioned to produce a feature film, *Grey Focus*, which took him on location to Nigeria.

He has worked in front and behind the cameras as well as on stage and off stage, leading productions with cast and crew of 20-100 with budgets ranging from \$30K-\$300K.

Baldemar Rodriguez was selected by the National Association of Latino Independent Producers for two of its signature program, The Producers Academy and the Writers Lab, where Rodriguez gave birth to the award winning feature film In Search of the American Dream. Baldemar Rodriguez is not only the Director of In Search of the American Dream - he wrote the screenplay and is the lead actor in the film.

He is an award winning Writer, Producer, Director and Editor. He has received several Communicator Awards and Telly Awards for his *Creativity in Editing and Cinematography*, a Remi Award for *Best Feature Film*, a CineFest Award for *Best Director* and was a recent nominee for the prestigious Imagen Award for *Best Director* of the feature film In Search of the American Dream.

His recent stage direction success is an original play by San Antonio playwright Alicia Mena, *Las Nuevas Tamaleras*. This comedy about young women trying to keep the tradition of making tamales, became a sold out sensation during the entire run of the play. Rodriguez plans on taking the premise of this stage play and taking it to the big screen in the near future.
