

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Houston (City) Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), through its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery (DR) Program for Hurricane Ike Round 1 Contract with the State of Texas, formerly under the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) and now with the Texas General Land Office (GLO), proposes to move \$2,390,040 uncommitted Multifamily funds to the Single Family Home Repair (SFHR) program. HCDD has received approval from the GLO Disaster Recovery staff to pursue an amendment to the original CDBG-DR Hurricane Ike Contract to move these funds. This proposal will neither increase nor decrease the number of homeowners proposed to be served under SFHR. This proposal also reduces the number of Multifamily units from 2,552 to 2,498. Here is a listing of the proposed changes:
