Funding

- Up to \$600,000 of total funding available.
- Projects will be funded with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Projects selected will operate on a reimbursement basis only
- Compliance with CDBG income, activity, servicearea eligibility and reporting criteria is required

Child Care and Out-of-School-Time Programming Priorities and NOFA Overview

Program Priorities

- HCD's Public Services team selects, funds, and manages key Houston nonprofits as sub-recipients to expand the services provided to Houston residents who are primarily low-to-moderate income or homeless.
- These service providers work on homelessness intervention, early childhood education, job training services, care for residents with intellectual and developmental disabilities, case management, and more.

Program Priorities

- HCD seeks nonprofit organizations ('Applicants') with 501(c)3 nonprofit status or similar nonprofit status that offer childcare services and/or out-of-school time enrichment services to youth ages 0-18 within the city of Houston.
- Services must be located within the City of Houston's jurisdiction

Program Priorities

- Proposed services should include:
 - Enrichment activities (education, art, sports, etc...)
 - Utilize evidence-based best practices to determine effectiveness and guide programming
 - Have measurable outcomes that benefit low-tomoderate income youth/households
 - Be a new or expansion of an existing program if not currently funded with City of Houston CDBG funds

Notice of Funding Availability Overview

- The program is funded primarily through CDBG funds via the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
- Funds will be provided on a reimbursement basis.
 Applicants must have at least 90 days of operating capital.
- Minimum \$100,000 / Maximum \$200,000 request.
- Twelve (12) months grant term.

THRESHOLD ITEMS

- ✓ Not debarred or suspended (City, State, Federal)
- In good standing with the City
- ✓ Certificate of Account Status
- ✓ Current 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) tax exempt status
- ✓ Site control (for proposed training location)
- Evidence of capital to support 3 months of operations
- Minimum of \$100,000 and maximum of \$200,000 request.
- ✓ Project meets CDBG income, activity, service-area eligibility criteria

Organization Management (15 points)

Experience and Past Performance (20 points)

Activity Need and Targeted Services (10 points)

Cost Reasonableness (10 points)

Budget Effectiveness (10 points)

Leveraging Contribution (5 points)

Program Effectiveness Using Evidence-Based Practices (20 points)

Agency Collaboration (10 points)



- Phone Number
- Preferred Contact Method
- Reason for Complaints or Appeal


Appeals

Appeal Tier Reviews

- Tier I: Program Area
- Tier II: Appeals Review Committee
- Tier III: State Escalation*

Important Timelines

- Appellant <u>MUST</u> file Appeal <u>in writing</u> within 30 days of award determination
- HCD acknowledges receipt within 1 business day
- Appellant has 5 days to submit supporting documentation
- HCD renders an Appeal Determination Letter within 45 days for NOFAs.



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



No Contact Period

- Neither Applicant(s) nor any person acting on Applicant(s') behalf shall attempt to influence the outcome of the award by the offer, presentation, or promise of gratuities, favors, or anything of value to any appointed or elected official or employee of the City, their families or staff members.
- All inquiries regarding the solicitation are to be directed to the designated City Representative identified on the first page of the NOFA.

No Contact Period

With the exception of Applicant's formal response to the solicitation and written requests for clarification during the period officially designated for such purpose by the City Representative, neither Applicant(s) nor persons acting on their behalf shall communicate with any appointed or elected official or employee of the City, their families, or staff through written or oral means in an attempt to persuade or attempt to persuade or influence the outcome of the award or to obtain or deliver information intended to or which could reasonably result in an advantage to any Applicant from the time of issuance of the solicitation through the pre-award phase and up to the date the City Secretary publicly posts notice of any City Council agenda containing the applicable award.

No Contact Period

 However, nothing in this paragraph shall prevent an Applicant from making public statements to the City Council convened for a regularly scheduled session after the official selection has been made and placed on the City Council agenda for action, or to a City Council committee convened to discuss a recommendation regarding the Application.
