## **Public Notice Correction**

On July 13, 2012, the City of Houston, through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle proposing a Substantial Amendment to its 2011 Annual Action Plan to delete/decrease the Neighborhood Facilities Unallocated line item and add an additional \$300,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding to Pro Vision, Inc. to expand its educational facility located in City Council District D at 4590 Wilmington, Houston, Texas 77051. The additional \$300,000 in funding is a 31.58% increase and brings the total grant amount to \$1,250,000 for the project. HCDD is issuing a correction to an error in the original notice. The additional \$300,000 CDBG funding will be provided through a Substantial Amendment to the 2010 Annual Action Plan; not the 2011 Annual Action Plan.

This Notice does not alter the original thirty day (30) comment period for this proposed item. The thirty-day period began on Friday, July 13, 2012 and runs through Sunday, August 12, 2012. Following the public comment period, the item will be submitted to City Council for approval.
