

Public Notice

The City of Houston, through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing to award \$350,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the unallocated Neighborhood Facilities (Private/Public) line item in various Annual Action Plans where funding is available, for the conversion of manually opening doors to automatically opening doors at the following multiservice centers (MSC) and health centers (HC):

- Fifth Ward MSC located at 4014 Market Street. The total budget of \$50,000 to replace the main entry doors to the MSC (1 double door) and the public restroom doors (4 doors).
- La Nueva Casa HC located at 1809 N Main Street. The total budget of \$40,000 to replace the main entry doors to the HC (2 double doors) and the public restroom doors (2 doors).
- Magnolia MSC/HC located at 7037 Capital. The total budget of \$70,000 to replace the main entry doors to the MSC/HC (3 double doors) and the public restroom doors (4 doors).
- Northeast MSC located at 9720 Spaulding. The total budget of \$70,000 to replace the main entry doors to the MSC (3 double doors) and the public restroom doors (4 doors).
- Northside HC located at 8504 Schuller. The total budget of \$60,000 to replace the main entry doors to the HC (3 double doors, 1 single door) and the public restroom doors (2 doors).
- Southwest MSC located at 6400 High Star. The total budget of \$60,000 to replace the main entry doors to the MSC (2 double doors) and the public restroom doors (4 doors).

The public has thirty days to comment on this proposed item. The thirty-day period extends from Friday, October 18, 2013 through Sunday, November 17, 2013.
