Public Notice

On May 23, 2014, the City of Houston, through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle proposing to award up to \$3,000,000 in HOME Investment Partnership Funds (HOME) funds from various Annual Action Plans where funding is available for the construction of Kissito Riverside Center for Healthy Living, a 112-unit affordable housing community located in City Council District D at 4320 Old Spanish Trail. On July 16, 2014, HCDD issued a correction to the original notice. Due to higher than expected construction costs, HCDD increased the award up to \$3,500,000 in HOME funds. HCDD is issuing a further correction. The location of the construction of the Kissito Riverside Center for Health Living, a 112-unit affordable housing community will now be located in City Council District I at 6901 Bellfort Avenue.

The original thirty-day public notice period began on Friday, May 23, 2014 and ended on Sunday, June 22, 2014. Due to the change in location, this additional public notice period begins on Wednesday, December 9, 2015 and ends on Friday, January 8, 2016.
