

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing to award a two-year contract up to \$120,000 in federal Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funding to the Coalition for the Homeless of Houston/Harris County to administer and operate the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS), a federally required information technology system used to collect data on the provision of housing and services to homeless persons or persons at-risk of homelessness.

The public has thirty days to comment on this proposed item. The thirty-day period extends from Saturday, February 20, 2016 through Monday, March 21, 2016.
