

## Public Notice Correction

On Wednesday July 11, 2018, the City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle proposing to allocate the Multifamily Hurricane Ike Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Disaster Recovery (DR) Program for Hurricane Ike Round 2, Phase 2 (CDBG-DR2) grant funds to three multifamily projects.

Park Yellowstone located at 3322 Yellowstone Blvd, was one of the projects listed, with a designated amount up to \$8,623,297 in CDBG-DR2 funds. HCDD is issuing a correction to the Public Notice to revise the proposed amount from \$8,623,297 to \$4,600,000.

This notice does not alter the original fifteen (15) day public comment period for this proposed item. The fifteen-day comment period began on Wednesday, July 11, 2018 and ended on Thursday, July 26, 2018. For more information on this proposed change, contact Kennisha London at (832) 394-6197.
