The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), was awarded Hurricane Ike Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Round 2 Program funding from the Texas General Land Office. The contract allowed the City to carry out multifamily activities which include rehabilitation, reconstruction, and new construction of subsidized housing for 524 households benefiting low-to-moderate income families. To date, the multifamily contract has had five amendments.

The CDBG-DR Program Rental Housing Projects Round 2 Grant Agreement (#13-181-00-7294) was executed on January 2, 2013 and expired on December 31, 2018. HCDD is requesting to extend the contract through December 31, 2019.

The public will have 15 days (fifteen) to comment on this proposed change. The fifteen-day period extends from Friday, January 25, 2019 through Saturday, February 9, 2019.
