

## Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) received \$87,092,000 of Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR15) funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to address unmet needs in areas impacted by 2015 flood events. The City, through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing to provide \$11,168,297.21 in CDBG-DR15 funds to the Houston Public Works Department (HPW) for the Neuens Road Drainage Project. This project, located along Neuens Road between Gessner Road and Blalock Road, will mitigate flooding and reduce localized drainage problems through drainage and paving improvements.

The public may comment on this proposed project during the 14-day comment period that extends from Wednesday, October 16, 2019 through Wednesday, October 30, 2019.
