

Public Notice Correction

On Friday, November 22, 2019 the City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle proposing to award Hurricane Harvey Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery 2017 grant funds (CDBG-DR 17) to six multifamily projects.

The Gale Winds Apartments was one of the projects listed. The Gale Winds Apartments located at 5005 Irvington Blvd., was listed with a designated amount up to \$1,226,750.00 in Hurricane Harvey CDBG-DR17 grant funds. HCDD is issuing a correction to the Public Notice to revise the proposed amount from \$1,226,750.00 to \$1,650,000.00. The increase in the proposed amount is due to the revision of the project's construction cost. This will maximize the rehabilitation efforts to ensure the project's viability and sustainability.

This notice does not alter the original thirty (30) day public comment period for this proposed item. The thirty-day comment period began on Friday, November 22, 2019 and ended on Sunday, December 22, 2019. For more information on this proposed change, contact Kennisha London at (832) 394-6197.
