## Public Notice

The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing a substantial amendment to the **Houston Action Plan for Disaster Recovery** – **2015 Flood Events** (Plan). The Strategic Buyout Program's language is being revised to replace "housing buyout" with "property buyout". This will expand the pool of properties eligible under the Strategic Buyout Program. This would be the fifth amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery 2015 (CDBG-DR15) Action Plan.
