

Public Notice

To help the City of Houston (City) prevent and respond to the impacts of COVID-19, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated an additional \$21.6 million Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (ESG-CV) funding to the City's Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) as apportioned by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

The **Amended 2019 Annual Action Plan** will serve as a grant application for the grant funds made available through the CARES Act that will be used to help prevent and respond to the impacts of COVID-19.
