

## Public Notice

To help the City of Houston (City) prepare for, prevent, and respond to the impacts of COVID-19, the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) has allocated \$5,868,597.28 in Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Grant Funds to the City's Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) as apportioned by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

The CDBG-CV funding will be used to provide rental assistance through the for the Texas Emergency Rental Assistance Program (TERAP), in an effort to assist income-eligible households impacted by COVID-19 to help them stay housed during the pandemic and help them recover economically from the impact of the pandemic.
