

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing a Substantial Amendment to the Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (ESG-CV) Grant Funds budget, transferring \$6,561,700.65 from Essential Services and Outreach Activities to Homeless Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Activities.

In accordance with HUD's Citizen Participation Plan regulations, the City is required to amend components of its Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan for a variety of reasons, including when a reallocation of funds increases or decreases the budget of an activity by more than 25% or when an activity is added or deleted in the Plan(s).
