

Public Notice Correction

On Tuesday, May 10, 2021 the City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle proposing to award Hurricane Harvey Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery 2017 grant funds (CDBG-DR 17) to two small rental projects, Tabor Street Homes and Old Spanish Trail.

Tabor Street Homes located at 1404 Tabor Street, Houston, TX 77009 was listed with a designated amount up to \$1,931,037.00 in Hurricane Harvey CDBG-DR17 grant funds. HCDD is issuing a correction to the Public Notice to revise the proposed amount from \$1,931,037.00 to \$2,403,786.00.

Old Spanish Trail located at 3500 Old Spanish Trail was listed with a designated amount up to \$1,989,897.00 in Hurricane Harvey CDBG-DR17 grant funds. HCDD is issuing a correction to the Public Notice to revise the proposed amount from \$1,989,897.00 to \$2,485,000.00.

This notice does not alter the original thirty (30) day public comment period for this proposed item. The thirty-day comment period began on Monday, May 10, 2021 and ended on Wednesday, June 9, 2021.
