

## Public Notice

The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing to allocate up to \$2,548,012.00 in HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) Funds to Harris Center for Mental Health and IDD to construct their proposed 6168 South Loop East Apartments, which will consist of 24 one-bedroom units and two one-bedroom ADA-accessible units in City Council District I. These funds will be used for construction costs.

The City, through HCDD, is proposing to allocate up to \$1,890,925.00 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds for improvements to Winzer Park located at 7300 Carver Road, Houston, TX 77088 – in City council District B. HCDD will make these funds available to the Houston Parks and Recreation Department (HPARD) and General Service Department (GSD).

The public has Thirty (30) days to comment on these proposed items. The thirty-day period extends from Wednesday, December 15, 2021 through Friday, January 14, 2022.
