To help the City of Houston (City) prevent and respond to the impacts of COVID-19, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated an additional \$310,778.49 Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus (ESG-CV) funding to the City's Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) as apportioned by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

The Amended 2019 Annual Action Plan describe the grant funds made available through the CARES Act that will be used to help prevent and respond to the impacts of COVID-19, and the following table shows how the new ESG-CV funds will be allocated. The additional allocation will be used for future emergency shelter activities to support facilities that provide temporary shelter and future administration activities to support the grant management and oversight.
