## Public Notice

On Wednesday, March 14, 2018, the City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle to identify and provide Community Development Block Grant -2015 Flood Events (CDBG-DR15) funds to the Houston Public Works Department (HPW) for the Spellman Detention Basin project.

The City is now proposing a First Amendment to the Letter of Agreement (LOA) between HCDD and HPW for the Spellman Detention Basin Project to:

- Update language within the Agreement to ensure language is in alignment with the federal requirements
- Extend the performance period to September 30, 2024
- Perform a budget modification to increase the funding amount

The total cost of the infrastructure Spellman Detention Basin project is estimated to be approximately \$29,688,858.00 of which **\$26,740,602** will be funded from the CDBG-DR15 Grant.
