Public Notice

The City of Houston ("City"), through its Housing and Community Development Department ("HCDD"), is issuing a public notice on a conflict of interest matter regarding two persons in relation to a potential increase in funding in the amount of \$813,142.14 to the Coalition for the Homeless of Houston/Harris County ("Coalition") for the rehabilitation and reconstruction of a navigation center located at 2903 Jensen Dr., Houston, Texas.

- A former Chief of Staff to a sitting City Council Member who is the son of Coalition board member, Lance Gilliam
- Coalition's Director of Strategic Planning, Mark Smith, served as the Interim Special Advisor to the Mayor for Homeless Initiatives from February to April 2023

HCDD is filing a request with the United States Housing and Urban Development Department for an exception to the conflict of interest prohibition under 24 C.F.R. 576.404(b) (3) provided that the recipient of funds, i.e, the City, has satisfactorily met the threshold requirements as follows:

- A disclosure of the nature of the conflict, accompanied by an assurance that there has been public disclosure and a description of how the public disclosure was made; and
- An opinion of the recipient's attorney that the interest for which the exception is sought would not violate state or local law.
