of material and labor costs, and project-related expenses due to ongoing market inflation of construction materials. St. Elizabeth Place offers proximity to employment centers and public transportation. The total project development will add affordable apartment units and contribute to the revitalization of the Lyons Avenue Corridor in Fifth Ward. The development will

consist of eighty five (85) total units, specifically twenty five (25)

efficiencies, fifty one (51) one-bedroom units, and nine (9) twobedroom apartment units. The City will restrict 51% (44) of the units for low- to moderate-income households earning below 80% of the Area Median Income. The loan and affordability period will be 40 years and will commence when the construction period is completed. The loan will be nonamortizing throughout both the construction and affordability

period. Following project completion, the outstanding principal balance of the note shall accrue at 1% interest. The borrower will pay an annual installment of interest from available cash flow.
