Public Notice

On Wednesday, Friday, June 23, 2017, the City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle to identify and provide Community Development Block Grant- 2015 Flood Events (CDBG-DR15) funds to the Houston Public Works Department (HPW) for two Infrastructure Storm Water Action Team (SWAT) Projects.

The City is now proposing a Third Amendment to the Letter of Agreement (LOA) between HCDD and HPW for the two DR15 Infrastructure SWAT Projects to:

- Update language within the Agreement to ensure language is in alignment with the federal requirements.
- Perform a budget modification to reduce funds for the Northside Northline SWAT 4A to reallocate to laboratory testing fees.

The total cost of the infrastructure SWAT projects is estimated to be approximately \$29,039,325.00 of which **\$28,319,325.00** will be funded from the CDBG-DR15 Grant.

The budget modification is being performed based on the costs of laboratory testing fees necessary to complete the project.

The public has fourteen (14) days to comment on this proposed amendment. The fourteen-day period extends from Friday, October 20, 2023, through Friday, November 3, 2023. Upon completion of the 14-day public comment period, HCDD will amend the Letter of Agreement with HPW for this project.
