

Public Notice

On Sunday, January 14, 2024, The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), posted a Public Notice in the Houston Chronicle proposing a Substantial Amendment to reallocate \$4,507,744.00 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from Public Facilities and Improvements activities to Economic Development activities to assist with the request of East End Maker Hub, Section 108 loan obligations. The City is issuing this notice to correct this amount from \$4,507,744.00 to \$3,372,745.00.

In accordance with HCDD's Citizen Participation Plan, the City is required to amend components of its Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan for a variety of reasons, including when changing the purpose, scope, location, or beneficiaries of an activity previously described in the Annual Action Plan.
