

## Public Notice

On Friday, April 12, 2024, The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) issued a public notice, proposing to allocate Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone (TIRZ) Funds, up to \$250,000.00, for the following participating agencies in its Public Services Program. The City is issuing a correction, proposing an additional allocation of funds to the Public Services Program through American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (ARPA-CLFRF), up to the amounts designated below, for the following participating agency.
