

## Public Notice

The City of Houston (“the City”), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) and Strategic Procurement Division, is proposing a First Amendment to two (2) existing contracts:

(1) Contract No. 4600018014, a contract between the City and 1919 Architects, P.C., and, (2) Contract No. 4600018183, a contract between the City and VCS Architects, LLC., both approved by Ordinance No. 2024-0327 and passed on May 15, 2024, for TIRZ-funded activities including (a) professional architectural and engineering design services, (b) architectural site concept planning, (c) green and sustainability planning and design, (d) structural engineering, and (e) civil engineering services to multiple single-family homes for various properties and sites in the metropolitan Houston area.

The First Amendment will revise contract language, adding a contract term of two (2) years with a one-year option to extend, corresponding with the term advertised in the Request for Qualifications. All other terms and conditions of both contracts shall remain the same. There will be no fiscal change.

The public has seven (7) days to comment on these proposed items. The seven-day period extends from Tuesday, July 30, 2024, through Tuesday, August 6, 2024. Upon completion of the 7-day public comment period, HCDD will take these items to City Council.
