

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is proposing a Letter of Agreement (LOA) between HCDD and Houston Public Works (HPW) for the Cambridge Park Village and Ramblewood Neighborhood Drainage and Paving Improvements Project. An allocation of \$6,075,790.00 in Community Development Block Grant Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) funds will be used for drainage and paving improvements within the park that will provide new storm sewers, construction of a dry bottom detention pond, and other improvements in low-to-moderate-income areas to create resiliency in the neighborhoods by reducing downstream flood risks while continuing to serve the community at large.

Cambridge Park Village Neighborhood Drainage and Paving Improvement Project

This project is generally bounded by bounded by Nitida Street on the west, Tidewater Drive on the south, HPD facility on the north, and the Ramblewood neighborhood to the east.

Ramblewood Neighborhood Drainage and Paving Improvement Project

This project is generally bounded by west end of Lotus Street and extends east to Buxley Street then continues north to the end of Buxley Street. In addition, includes Woodmont Drive and Avonelle Lane, Woodmont Drive and Grantmoor Lane, and at the west end of Brookston Street.

The total cost of the projects is estimated to be approximately \$10,396,146.00 of which **\$6,075,790.00** will be funded from the CDBG-MIT Grant.

The public has thirty (30) days to comment on these proposed items. The thirty-day period extends from Monday, May 20, 2024, through Thursday, June 20, 2024.
