The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) is proposing an Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreements for the following participating agencies funded with Community Development Block Grant – CARES Act (CDBG-CV), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and HOME Investment Partnerships Program – American Rescue Plan Act (HOME-ARP) funds. The proposed amendments will extend the subrecipient agreement term. There are no changes to the scope or funding.
