

Public Notice

The City of Houston (City) through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), requests City Council to authorize and approve a Tenth Amendment to the Hurricane Ike Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR 2) Program Rental Housing Projects Round 2 Subrecipient Agreement (#13-181-000-7294) between the City and the Texas General Land Office (GLO). The proposed amendment will extend the term of the agreement from September 30, 2024, to August 31, 2025, and revise contractual language. There will be no changes to the funding.

The Subrecipient Agreement allowed the City to carry out multifamily activities which included rehabilitation, reconstruction, and new construction of subsidized housing benefiting low-to-moderate income families. The proposed extension accommodates the completion and closeout of the St. Elizabeth Place Rehabilitation Project, an 85-unit Multifamily rental housing complex in the Lyons Avenue Corridor in Houston's Fifth Ward.

The public has fifteen (15) days to comment on these proposed items. The fifteen-day period extends from Friday, October 25, 2024, through Saturday, November 9, 2024.
