In the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024 (Public Law 118-42) (the Act), U.S. Congress made Economic Development Initiative for the purposes of Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending (CPF) awards available, and projects were identified in the annual appropriations legislation.
