A CARING SAFE PLACE, INC. Administers and operates two community residences, which provides housing and supportive services for persons with chemical addiction and/or alcohol dependency problems. 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The eligibility requirements for HOPWA-funded services are very basic, but there are several housing options for people living with HIV who have a low or fixed income, as well as for those with special needs. Participants in the HOPWA Program must meet the following requirements to be eligible to receive services:

- Meet the definition of low-to-moderate income; for Tenant Based Rental Assistance and Community Resources must be at 50% or below AMI (for current AMI amounts visit https://bit.ly/coh-ami)
- Have an HIV positive diagnosis; and
- Live in the Houston EMSA (Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area) Principal Cities: Houston, The Woodlands, Sugar Land, Baytown, Conroe, and Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, and Waller counties.

Please check with the service provider for additional eligibility requirements, restrictions, and limitations.
