## \$1.4 Million Dollar Grant Funds H.P.A.R.D.'s After-School Meal Program Offers Free Snack & Mealfor Area YouthAt 76 Sites PROGRAM AVAILABLE TO YOUTH AGES 1TO 18

Mayor Annise Parker and the Houston Parks and Recreation Department (H.P.A.R.D.) are happy to announce that the After-School Meal Program willbe offered at 76 sites across Houston this year. The After-School Meal program is funded by a \$1.4 million grant from the Texas Department of Agriculture (T.D.A.) Child and Adult Care Food Program (C.A.C.F.P.). Sites were approved by the Texas Department of Agriculture based on T.D.A. eligibility requirements which designate eligible areas as those served by a school in which 50% or more of the children are eligible to receive free or reduced-priced meals.

"We are very excited to be able to offer the After School Meal Program at 76 sites across Houston," said Mayor Annise Parker. "This program helps address the problem of hunger faced by many school age children in the Houston area. No child should have to go without the nourishment needed to fuel their brains for the demands of learning."

The Texas Department of Agriculture C.A.C.F.P. program offers free snacks and suppers to youth ages 1 to 18 who participate in H.P.A.R.D.'s programming or at approved partner sites. This program runs during the school year, September 2, 2014 – May 28, 2015.

"We all remember coming home after school and heading for the refrigerator to see what we could snack on," said Joe Turner, Director, Houston Parks and Recreation Department. "Thanks to this grant, we can make sure that the young people we serve will not go hungry. Our participating community centers and partners will now be able to provide them with free nutritious and healthy snacks and meals."

Young people, ages 1 to 18, will be served a free snackand supper between the hours of 3:00 pm and 6:00 pm Monday through Friday at participating H.P.A.R.D. Community Centers and approved partner sites. H.P.A.R.D. manages the program for the City of Houston and participating sites are sponsored under H.P.A.R.D.

There are no enrollment requirements for the C.A.C.F.P. program. The facility hosting the program must provide educational or enrichment activities, be open to all children, and not limit participation or membership on the basis of the child's ability.H.P.A.R.D. accepts registrations throughout the year from groups interested in becoming an After-School Meal Program site.Interested groups that would like to apply to become an After School Meal Program siteshould contact Rummeka Allen at (832) 395-7284.
