



# EAST HOUSTON

## Neighborhood Resilience Planning DATA SNAPSHOT

The Neighborhood Resilience Planning study for East Houston is bounded by Union Pacific Railroad to the north, and partially to the west followed by Ley Road and Houston Road. It is made up of a collection of smaller neighborhoods in the northeastern part of Houston. One of its communities, Verde Forest, was annexed into the city in 1996. Data included here has been compiled from the latest American Community Survey five-year estimates in 2022.



East Houston is largely made up with single-family homes with a major industrial park located on the southeast corner of the neighborhood. Much of its open green spaces surrounds Halls Bayou that runs through the area and where a city's golf course, Brock Park, is found. There are several schools in the area, including one early childhood center. East Houston is approximately 6,833 acres (10.68 sq. miles).
