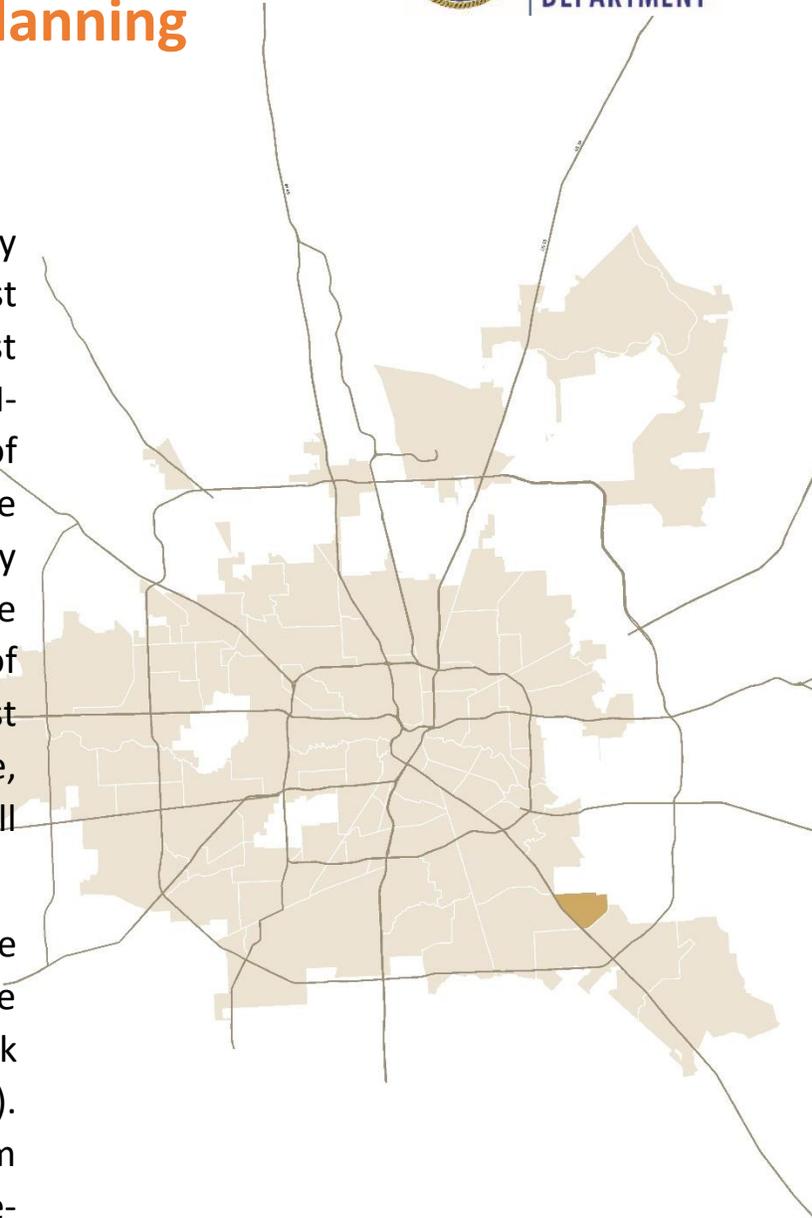
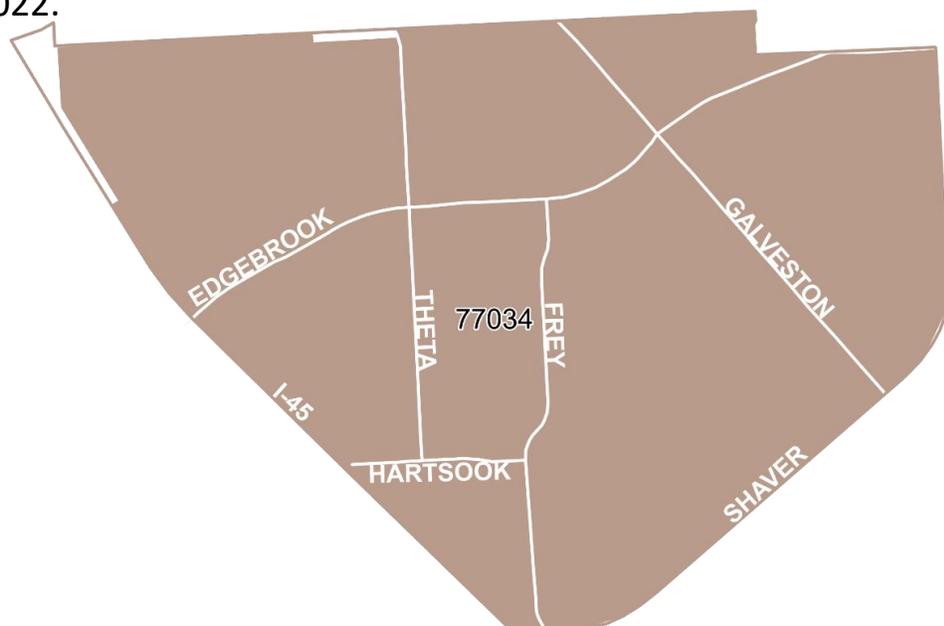
## Neighborhood Resilience Planning DATA SNAPSHOT

The Neighborhood Resilience Planning study for Edgebrook is situated in southeast Houston, where Shaver Street forms the east and southern boundaries and Gulf Freeway/I-45 sets the western boundary. The City of South Houston is located north of the neighborhood. The opening of the Freeway spurred development in the area. The Edgebrook area is comprised of a group of subdivisions. Freeway Manor is its oldest subdivision, followed by Gulfway Terrace, Sun Valley, and Arlington Heights, all developed in the 1950s.

Many large apartment complexes can be found in the neighborhood in addition to the single-family home subdivisions. Edgebrook is approximately 1,919 acres (3 sq. miles). Data included here has been compiled from the latest American Community Survey five-year estimates in 2022.
